SCHOOLS BEGIN 7/22/09

**STUDENTS NEED:**

**Preschool, Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will need a physical exam and current immunizations in order to start school in July or August, 2009. State REQUIRES that parent complete & sign health history portion of physical.**

**PRESCHOOL:**

Physical exam dated 8/26/08 (7/22/08 for CLC schools) or later. A diabetes screening is required. Lead screening is required. A Mantoux test for tuberculosis is recommended.

- DPT/DTaP 4 doses (including 1 booster)
- IPV/OPV 3 doses
- Varicella 1 dose after 12 months or proof of immunity
- MMR 1 dose after 12 months
- Hepatitis B 3 doses
- Hib 1 dose after 15 months

**KINDERGARTEN:**  
(or first entry  
in Illinois school)

Physical exam dated 8/26/08 (7/22/08 for CLC schools) or later. A diabetes screening is required. Lead screening is required. A Mantoux test for tuberculosis is recommended. \*Dental Exam required—see below.

**NEW REQUIRMENT: VISION EXAM COMPLETED BY LICENSED DOCTOR.**

- DPT/DTaP 4 doses (last one after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- IPV/OPV 3 doses (last one after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- Varicella 1 dose after 12 months or proof of immunity
- MMR 2 doses after 12 months  
or
- Measles 2 doses after 12 months
- Mumps 1 dose after 12 months
- Rubella 1 dose after 12 months

**5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE:**

**NEW LEGISLATION: NOT REQUIRED TO HAVE A SCHOOL PHYSICAL BUT DO NEED TO SHOW PROOF OF HEP B SERIES**

**6<sup>TH</sup> GRADE:**

Physical exam dated 8/26/08 (7/22/08 for CLC schools) or later. A diabetes screening is required. A Mantoux test for tuberculosis is recommended.

**7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE: New Law\***

Proof of 1 dose of Varicella Vaccine or Proof of having had Chicken Pox

**9<sup>TH</sup> GRADE:**

Physical exam dated 8/26/08 or later. A diabetes screening is required. A Mantoux test for tuberculosis is recommended.  
Td booster (if Td has not been received in past 10 years.)

The Illinois School Code requires students to submit a report of physical examination and the dates that certain immunizations were received in order to attend school.

**MAKE APPOINTMENTS EARLY**

\*A dental examination is required for all children in kindergarten, second and sixth grade. The examination by a licensed dentist must be completed by May 15<sup>th</sup> of the school year that the child is in kindergarten, second or sixth grade.

\*New state legislation effective September 2007 changes physical requirement from 5<sup>th</sup> grade to 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
