Academic/Career Counseling	Advisement and program coordination to promote students' academic and career success.
Accounting	Maintenance and audit of accounts and the preparation of reports for financial and tax compliance.
Actuarial Science	Analysis of statistical data and construction of probability tables to forecast risk and liability.
Aerospace Engineering	Design, construction, and testing of aircraft, missiles, and spacecraft.
Air Force	The military branch which performs aerial warfare functions as part of the U.S. Armed Forces.
Architecture	Planning and design of building structures and property.
Army	The military branch which serves as the ground fighting force as part of the U.S. Armed Forces.
Art and Illustration	The design of visual productions and media such as print, broadcasting, video, and film.
Automotive Engineering	Development of new or improved designs for vehicle body and internal components.
Automotive Maintenance	Diagnosis, adjustment, repair, or overhaul of automotive vehicles.
Automotive Sales	Retail sales profession for new and used automobiles and related automotive products.
Banking	Management of resources related to debt, credit, capital markets, money, and investments.
Biology and Chemistry	Research and study of the basic principles of the life and natural sciences and their applications.
Child and Youth Services	Delivery of education, health, and wellness related services to children and youth.
Civil Engineering	Performance of engineering duties in construction of buildings, bridges, dams and roads.
Clinical Lab Technology	Performance of medical laboratory tests for the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of disease.
CNC and Machine Operations	Staging and operation of a variety of machine tools to produce or modify precision parts and instruments.
Communications	Business of conveying information through broadcast, publications, digital media, and telecommunications.
Cosmetology	Performance of beauty service functions related to hair, face, nail, and skin services.
Culinary Arts	Art of food preparation and presentation within restaurants and other food service operations.
Cyber Security	Planning and implementation of security measures for the protection of computer networks and information.
Dentistry	Examining, diagnosing, and treating diseases, injuries, and malformations of teeth and gums.
Design/Mechanical Engineering	Engineering discipline specializing in the plan and design of products and systems.
Early Education	Teaching academic and social skills to students at the elementary school level.
Electrical Services	Researching, designing, testing, or overseeing the manufacturing and installation of electrical equipment.
Emergency Medical Services	Assessing injuries and illnesses and administering basic emergency medical care.
Entrepreneurial Science	The science of applying a business concept or idea through conception, funding, and development.
Environmental Engineering	Engineering discipline specializing in management and protection of natural resources and the environment.
Event Planning	Organization and management of meetings, conventions, celebrations, and promotions.
Fire Safety	Inspection of buildings to detect fire hazards and investigations to determine cause of fires and explosions.
Graphic Design	The design or creation of graphics to meet specific commercial or promotional needs.
Green Technology	Utilization of technical applications and designs that conserve and protect natural resources.
Horticulture	The art and practice of plant cultivation and garden management.
Human Resources	Planning, directing, and coordinating of human resources activities and staff of an organization.
Industrial Maintenance	Repair and preventative maintenance of equipment and machines used in industrial settings.
Information Systems	System of hardware and software components for collecting, creating, storing, and distributing information.
Interpretation/Translation	Translation orally and in writing for parties conversing in different languages.
Investment Services	Management of investment accounts or funds in an advisory capacity to maximize financial resources.
Journalism	The profession of writing or preparing news for newspapers, magazines, websites, or broadcasts.
Lawyer	Represent, manage, or advise clients in criminal and civil litigation and other legal proceedings.
Library Science	Administration and maintenance of libraries or collections of information for public or private access.

Lobbyist	A person who takes part in an organized attempt to influence legislators.
Marines/Navy	The military branch responsible to perform naval and amphibious warfare as part of the U.S. Armed Forces.
Medical Imaging	Creation of x-rays, MRI's and CAT scans or diagnostic or research purposes.
Mental Health Counseling	Counseling and advisement to promote optimum mental and emotional health with an emphasis on prevention.
Mfg and Quality Engineering	Engineering discipline specializing in manufacturing operations and quality control.
Nursing	Assessing and addressing patient health care needs.
Nutrition	Planning and production of food service or nutritional programs to promote health and help control disease.
Paralegal	Assist lawyers by investigating facts, preparing legal documents, or researching legal precedent.
Performing Arts	Performance on stage, television, radio, video, film, or other production settings.
Photography	Documenting images of people, landscapes, merchandise, or other subjects.
Physician Assistant	Provides healthcare services typically performed by a physician under the supervision of a physician.
Physics	Study of the nature and properties of matter and energy.
Police Services	Public services and investigations related to violations of federal, state, or local laws to prevent or solve crimes.
Post Secondary Administration	Planning, directing and coordinating of academic, administrative, or auxiliary activities of a college or university.
Public Administration	Planning and administration of services provided by municipalities and other governmental organizations.
Public Relations	Managing the relationship between the public and a company or other organization.
School Administration	The administrative leadership of a school district.
Secondary School Administration	Planning and coordination of academic and administrative services for middle and high school students.
Secondary School Teaching	Providing instruction in one or more subjects to students at the middle and high school levels.
Sign Language	The utilization of visual signs to deliver communications to deaf individuals.
Social Media	The use of websites and applications to create and share content or to participate in social networking.
Social Work	Providing social services to improve the social and psychological functioning of individuals and families.
Software Development	Researching, designing, and developing of computer and network software or specialized programs.
Sound and Stage Production	The production of sound and stage effects for broadcast, theatre, and video environments.
Therapeutic Services	Planning and delivery of rehabilitative programs to improve or conditions resulting from disease or injury.
Tourism	The promotion of places and activities of interest to grow visitations.
Veterinary Science	Diagnosis, treatment, and research of diseases and injuries impacting small and large animals.
Video Production	Development, production, and editing of video and other forms of related media.
Web Design	The development of websites, web applications, and databases, and interactive interfaces.
Welding	Using hand-welding, flame-cutting, hand-soldering, or brazing equipment to weld or join metal components.
World Languages	The study of multiple languages, usually in conjunction with a career choice or continuation of studies.
