Abbott's School Wide Zoom Expectations

The Abbott Middle School SIP/SD team came up with a list of zoom expectations for teachers and students to follow during distance learning. Please be sure to enforce these in your virtual classrooms so we have a **universal plan across our school**.

- 1. Student must use your real full name when logging into zoom sessions (first and last name)
- 2. Students are highly encouraged to use their video to increase engagement and learning opportunities; however if your video cannot be turned on please use a photo of yourself
- 3. Mute yourself except when talking; this limits background noise
- 4. Make sure you are in an appropriate environment or use a background
- 5. Be appropriate and respectful; treat it like a regular classroom

If these expectations are not followed please teachers will use in class, restorative approaches to improve the behavior. If there are still concerns after multiple attempts to help the student, the teacher will contact the student's parent/guardian, as well as support staff or administrations for assistance.
