

IAR Report Card:

The enclosed report reflects your child's performance on the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) from Spring 2023. The IAR is like an educational GPS, providing insight into how your student is progressing in relation to the Illinois Learning Standards. It helps identify what your student needs to master to be prepared for the next grade level and, ultimately, for success in high school, college, and future careers.

Parents, you play a key role in supporting your child's education by making regular school attendance a priority. Establishing strong attendance habits starts early, and as a parent, you can ensure your child develops this essential routine. Students who attend school regularly not only benefit from classroom learning but also remain engaged and on track for graduation. <u>The application window is now open</u> and closes on Monday, Oct. 25. This window is the only time students can apply for Magnet Academy admission.




