Message from the Principal

This week kicked off the second 9 weeks for the semester. Progress reports have been posted and can be accessed through Infinite Campus. The end of the week brought us parent/teacher conferences. For those that were able to attend conferences, we appreciate you taking the time to meet with us. I hope that your conferences were able to provide you with some valuable insight



into your child's progress in school. If you were unable to meet, please do not hesitate to reach out to your child's teachers to check in on their progress. We look forward to our continued partnership throughout the remainder of the school year. If you have any questions or concerns regarding your child or their classroom, please do not hesitate to contact that teacher. Open communication should be occurring throughout the year, not just during parent teacher conferences.

Parents, we also need your help with some behavioral incidents we are starting to see more and more. If you can please have a conversation with your students about expectations while at school, we would appreciate your support.

- CELL PHONES ~ The use of cellphones in school continues to be a problem. Unfortunately, at
 this age, our students have a hard time understanding appropriate use of their cell phones, that
 is why we ask that they are "Off and AWAY for the DAY". Please help support us by asking your
 students to either keep their cell phones in their lockers or do not bring them to school. If you
 need to get a hold of your student, we can call them down and if they need to talk to you, they
 just need to come to the main office.
- IN THE DOOR IN 4! ~ That is our Tardy Policy. As students start to get more comfortable around school, we are seeing an increase in tardies. If a student is habitually tardy to class, consequences will be applied. You can always see your students' attendance and tardies in Infinite Campus.
- WATER BOTTLES ~ We are experiencing an increase in the number of students who feel it is funny to squirt others with their water bottle. Unfortunately, not only does the recipient get upset but the floor gets wet which causes slipping issues in the hallway. We are especially

seeing this with the water bottles that squirt from the top. Please have a conversation with your child about appropriate use of their water bottles.

As always, this work is a partnership between home and school. Only together can we help to ensure a safe learning environment for all of our children.



STUDENT GRADES IN INFINTE CAMPUS

Parent engagement is crucial to academic success, and as a District, we want to ensure our parents are informed and engaged in their child's education. With parent-teacher conferences taking place this week, we want to remind parents/guardians how to access the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. This is an online tool that gives parents and guardians access to their child's attendance, teacher's contact information, and bus schedule (if applicable). Most importantly, it allows parents of children in 1st through 12th grades to view their grades, which are regularly updated.

Remember that parents can <u>customize the settings</u> to be notified about assignment and grade updates.

To be considered for a U-46 Magnet Academy, students are required to have a 2.0 GPA and two letters of recommendation.


