# FROM THE NURSE'S OFFICE

Cold and Flu season are in full effect - we have seen increased cases of respiratory illnesses including Flu, RSV, and Covid at school. As a reminder, <u>please do not send your student to school if</u> <u>they are sick and have symptoms including:</u>

- Fever (100.4°F or higher)
- new onset of moderate to severe persistent headache

- shortness of breath
- new cough
- sore throat
- vomiting
- diarrhea
- new loss of sense of taste or smell

\*\*Also as a reminder - students are **NOT** allowed to bring medicine to school. This includes cough drops, Vick's VapoRub, nasal sprays, Tylenol, ibuprofen, etc..


### ATTENDANCE MATTER!
