PICK UP REMINDERS

If you pick up your student after school, you might have seen the increase in traffic we are experiencing. Monday - Thursday we have elementary band and orchestra pick up at 3:15 each week. This adds between 20-80 more cars in the parking lot depending on the day. We are asking that you please be patient and **kind** when picking up your students.
