8th GRADE TRIP

8th Grade Trip permission slips are available for students to pick up in the commons during their lunch hours. Signed permission slips and \$30 (cash or check made out to Kenyon Woods Middle School) needs to be turned in by May 12, 2023. Money is non-refundable and students must adhere to the following behavior and academic requirements for 4th quarter to be able to attend:

- Students will have no Out of School Suspensions (OSS)
- Students cannot be placed in In School Intervention (ISI) more than twice
- Students must be passing 5 of their 7 classes including electives, PE and Health, with a D or higher
- -tudents can not have reached the "Loss of Privilege" status of the Kenyon Woods Middle School Tardy Policy (8 tardies to a single class or 20 tardies total across all classes)

Students who do not meet this criteria will remain at school on the day of the trip and will follow their regular class schedule.

SUMMER PROGRAMS FOR MIDDLE SCHOOLERS

<u>June 7th - July 7th</u> - For middle school students, the summer program will engage students in a variety of academic enrichment opportunities that include STEM, Humanities, and elective courses. Middle school summer programming is open to any current 6th - 8th grade U-46 students and will be hosted at Kenyon Woods Middle School. There are a limited number of seats available, and registration is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
