Kenyon Woods Middle School has refreshed its tardy policy to emphasize the importance of punctuality and the impact it can have on students' academic performance and future habits. The idea of teaching students the expectation of arriving to class on time and following through with the tardy policy is a positive step toward creating a more disciplined and focused learning environment.



Setting a "IN THE DOOR IN 4" rule with a four-minute window for students to get to their class on time is a reasonable expectation. It provides ample time for students to navigate the building and avoid socializing in the halls or taking unnecessary laps during passing periods. It's crucial for students to understand the value of their instructional time and the importance of making the most of it.

Parent support is indeed vital in reinforcing these expectations. When parents and the school work together to emphasize the importance of punctuality, it sends a consistent message to students. Encouraging open communication between parents, teachers, and students can help address any issues or challenges that may arise with the new policy.

Promoting good time management and punctuality skills at a young age can have a lasting positive impact on students' academic and professional development. It's an important aspect of their overall education and preparation for the future.

We are collecting \$4.00 for the tri fold posters which students must use. (This is a great deal since these boards sell for almost \$10 at


retail price.) Please send the \$4.00 cash with your child to their social studies teacher. Money is due October 17.

The Spectacular 2023 Annular Eclipse: A Celestial Ballet

On October 14, 2023, the skies will play host to a celestial spectacle: an annular solar eclipse. This rare and mesmerizing event occurs when the moon passes between the Earth and the Sun, creating a cosmic ballet that captivates observers around the



world. Unlike a total eclipse, where the moon fully covers the sun, during an annular eclipse, the moon covers the center of the sun, leaving a dazzling "ring of fire" around its edges. Let's delve into the marvels of this natural phenomenon.

The 2023 annular eclipse will offer a front-row seat to observers in a select band of regions. This time, the prime viewing locations will include regions of Oregon, Utah, Nevada, Texas, and Mexico. In our region, we are only treated to a partial spectacle capable of slightly dimming our skies. Saturday's, eclipse serves as a reminder of the grandeur and mystery of our universe. They unite people across the globe in shared moments of amazement and contemplation. And if this event sparks your curiosity about eclipses, you may always make plans to witness the Monday, April 8th, 2024 total solar eclipse visible from locations in southern Illinois.
