8th Grade Recognition Program

The Eighth Grade Recognition Program is scheduled for Wednesday, May 29th, 2024 at 6:00 PM at South Elgin High School gymnasium. Each family will receive 6 tickets; the 8th grade student does not need a ticket for the event. Due to the number of tickets each family is receiving, we will not be issuing additional tickets. Please plan accordingly. All eighth graders are

invited to attend this evening activity. This ceremony is not a graduation, but a celebration of the middle school years. **The program will begin promptly at 6 PM**.

8th grade recognition guidelines:

- Doors will open at 5:30 PM.
- Each student will have 6 tickets for guests. Each guest must have a ticket to enter the gym. All school fees must be paid in order to receive tickets.
- Special awards presented at the end of the evening.
- Dress code for the evening: boys dress slacks/shorts, nice jeans (no rips or holes), dress shirt or polo type shirt. Girls – casual dresses, skirts and blouses or slacks. Clothing should cover all appropriate areas at all times. Appropriate areas include: stomach, chest and sides (both male and female) Shorts, jeans and tee shirts are not appropriate for either males or

females. Guests – dress comfortably. While the gym is air-conditioned, it will get extremely warm when crowded.

- Due to the large number of people who attend this event and the restriction we have on the number of spectators allowed in the stands, extra tickets will NOT be issued.
- No balloons, large signs or noise makers will be allowed into the gymnasium.
- The program is only 1 hour, please be courteous of everyone else and plan to stay until the end.

8th Grade Dance

The Eighth Grade Dance will be held on <u>Thursday, May 2nd, 2024</u>. The dance will be held at Villa Olivia and will include a sit down dinner with dancing to follow. The dance begins at 6:00 PM and ends at 8:30 PM. Tickets are on sale right now. The cost is \$20 and payment is due to the Main Office by April 26th. - Students must bring their school ID and students will not have access to their phones during the dance.
- All fees and fines must be paid in full, before dance tickets are purchased.
