WATER BOTTLE POLICY

Please note, this policy is meant to keep our students, staff and school environment safe. NO Metal Cups/Containers will be allowed! This includes Yetis and Stanleys

- The container must contain water and water only. No juice, soda, coffee, or energy drinks.
- The container must have a closable lid, which can be a screwon lid or a push top.
- The water bottle must be clear or see-through. Tinted water bottles are allowed as long as the bottle's contents are visible.
- The student will be responsible for filling the bottle between classes. A student may not leave class to fill a bottle.
- Individual teachers will determine the appropriate use of water bottles and/or the appropriate place to utilize them safely. They will communicate their expectations with their class.



ARRIVAL TO SCHOOL PROCEDURES

Students are expected to arrive promptly to school each and every day. Students are expected to wear their ID upon entering school property. The earliest students may be dropped off at school is **8:30 am** unless they are meeting with a teacher.

Students arriving to school on time:



- Student arriving by bus will enter through door # 20 and report to the cafeteria until the first bell rings at 8:50.
 - Students being dropped off will also enter through door # 20 and report to the cafeteria until the first bell rings at 8:50.

Students arriving late to school:

Students will enter through the main entrance (door 1). They will need to show their ID in order to enter the building or will need to purchase a new ID.

Only visitors to school will be allowed to enter through the main entrance (door 1) before 8:50 am. Please see our map for drop off and pick up traffic patterns.

MY STOP SCHOOL BUS TRACKING APP

Versatrans My Stop™ helps parents and guardians of U-46 students who ride the bus track the location of their child's bus. The app is updated automatically with GPS information about the current location of the bus, which will especially be helpful when there are weather or traffic

delays. However, the information on My Stop does not guarantee or supersede scheduled times, as computers and GPS signals may have glitches or delays. Please have your child ready and waiting at their bus stop prior to the scheduled time listed in Infinite Campus. Bus substitutions may not always be reflected.

EVERY MINUTE MATTERS

Daily attendance is a huge key to a successful school year! It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to call the attendance office within 24 hours of any absence and verify the reason for the absence.

CELL PHONES SHOULD BE AWAY FOR THE DAY!

All middle schools in the district will be following the district guidelines of "AWAY FOR THE DAY" for cell phone usage. Students will not be allowed to use their cell phones during the school day, including during lunch, in the locker room or bathrooms. These district-wide middle school guidelines support classroom learning and improved culture and climate efforts for all middle school students in order to minimize distractions and help teachers create and manage a classroom and school environment conducive to



learning, discussion and collaboration. It also helps protect students against bullying and/or inappropriate social media use during school hours, which are often exacerbated by cell phone access.

Consistent with our secondary cell phone guidelines overall, students are expected to put their silenced or powered-off cell phone in their locker upon arriving at school. Our intention is to help students create better habits when in learning environments. If students are unable to keep devices out of sight and in their lockers, teachers may provide a warning and remind/ask their students to

put the phone away in their lockers or cell phone holders until the end of the period. If students do not comply and continue to engage in electronic device misuse, progressive discipline procedures will be followed. This may include, but is not limited to, the following consequences: having the student turn over his/her phone to the main office for parent pick up, or issuance of referrals resulting in detentions and other discipline-related interventions.

Parents - If you need to get a hold of your student during the day, please call the main office and we will either relay your message or bring your student to the main office for you to speak to them directly.

DRESS FOR SUCCESS

Students can choose clothing that makes them feel comfortable and safe, as long as it complies with the following guidelines:

- 1. Does not depict any violence, hatred, drugs, alcohol, gang affiliation, profanity, phobic language or cruelty of any kind
- 2. Covers all appropriate areas at all times. Appropriate areas include: stomach, chest and sides (both male and female) and butt/pelvic/upper thigh areas.
- 3. Items such as tank tops, sleeveless shirts, any type of shorts, coats, jackets, etc. are all allowed provided they adhere to #2 of this Section. (Low backs are not a problem)
- 4. Jewelry is allowed, unless it becomes a safety concern.
- 5. Hats, hoods, and other types of head coverings are not allowed unless required for religious or medical purposes.
- 6. Footwear must be worn for health reasons (cannot go shoeless). **Due to safety concerns, Flip Flops and Slides are not to be worn in school.**

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STUDENT IDs

As a measure to ensure student safety, **Students must wear an undefaced school ID on a Kenyon Woods breakaway lanyard above their waist** while on campus during regular school hours. Students who arrive to school without their ID 's will need to wear a temporary ID. Upon the 2nd infraction, students will be issued disciplinary consequences.

BACKPACK POLICY

Backpacks should be used only to bring items back and forth to school. Once at school, all backpacks MUST be kept in the student's locker. During the school day, students are allowed to carry a small purse, pencil case, or zippered binders. If you student is struggling to keep themselves organized, please have them reach out to their counselors for help.





VISITORS TO THE SCHOOL

Only visitors on official school business are permitted on school grounds.

All visitors to KWMS must display a valid picture ID upon entrance to the main office and clearly display their visitors pass while on campus. At the conclusion of their visit, visitors will return to the main office to sign-out, return their visitors pass, and leave

campus. The KWMS administration reserves the right to regulate visitations on campus.
