EVERY MINUTE MATTERS

Daily attendance is a huge key to a successful school year! It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to call the attendance office within 24 hours of any absence and verify the reason for the absence.

DID YOU KNOW:

- According to the State of Illinois, student must be in school for at least 300 instructional minutes to be considered present for a full day. Our day is 315 minutes long.
- Present for 150 299 instructional minutes is considered a half day
- Present for 0 149 instructional minutes equals a full absence.
- This means if you miss more than 15 minutes in a day, you are absent for a half day!

BECOME AN OBSERVER ON YOUR CHILD'S CANVAS COURSE

If you would like to become an observer on your child's class canvas pages (most teachers put all classwork here), please follow the directions on this link. Please note that your child will need to be present in order to generate a code for you on his/her canvas account as per the directions.

How to Be Added as an Observer to a Class Canvas Page

Parents can be added to a Canvas page as observers. Students can generate a pairing code for each parent observer they want to link to their Canvas account. The observer can then enter the code in their User Settings Observing tab.

Here are some steps to add a parent as an observer:

- Click Account
- Click Settings
- Under Ways to Connect, click Pair with Observer
- A code will be generated. This code is case sensitive, so it's recommended to copy or write it down
- The parent can then create a Canvas account using the institution's Canvas URL. They can type in <u>u46.instructure.com</u> and select Login to Canvas as a Parent.
- In the app, the parent can click Find School and type in the district. They can then select Parents as the pairing option.

Once linked, the parent observer can view the student's course content, such as announcements and assignment due dates, but they can't participate in the course. They can also use the Inbox to message teachers.

BOYS CROSS COUNTRY




If you are interested in joining Boy's Cross Country this year please pick up an informational packet in the commons during lunch periods this week or next week!
