# Student Pick-up/Drop off

We are continuing to encourage all parents to observe safe procedures when picking up or dropping off students from school. Waiting a few extra minutes to pick up your child reduces the risk of an accident or injury. Please follow the guidelines below when picking your child up from school:

- Please drive along the curb and pull up to the orange cone to wait for your child. The curb is the only area where parking to wait for students is allowed. Cars that have stopped in the thru lane (double parked), on the inner curve of the drive, or on the left side of the thru lane will be told to move on and circle back to pick up their child.
- Please do not move the orange cones to pull through the parking lot.
- Be sure students exit the car on the curb side only for safety.

- If the car in front of you moves forward, continue to slowly move forward in an orderly traffic pattern.
- Please do not exit your vehicle when parked at the curb to meet your child at the front door.
- Please do not park in the parking spaces to cross the traffic lane and move between parked cars to pick up your child.
- The first bell rings at 8:20 am. Students need to be in the classrooms ready to learn at 8:30 am.
