Bartlett Elementary School Back Loop Vehicle Lane Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures:

- 1. We would prefer that you avoid parking in the Bartlett Elementary School parking lot for drop off (arrival) and pick up (dismissal) for the safety of students and ease of flow of vehicles through the Back Loop Vehicle Lane. Please use our designated Back Loop Vehicle Lane for drop off and pick up.
- 2. Enter the Back Loop Vehicle Lane from Oneida Avenue. Vehicle traffic will move north from Oneida in a single line of vehicles. Please stay on the right side of the lane as close to the curb as possible.
- 3. Vehicles should continue to move forward in the Back Loop Vehicle Lane whenever possible to avoid any gaps in the line and allow for an efficient process.
- 4. We have designated a drop off / pick up zone as a section of the front of the Back Loop Vehicle Lane where students should be dropped off and picked up. It will be marked off with cones. Vehicles should pull all of the way forward in this zone before dropping off or picking up students. For pick up, students should keep an eye out for their vehicle so that they can be ready to board efficiently and safely.
- 5. Students should exit/enter vehicles from the <u>curb side</u> only. If there are multiple students exiting or entering a vehicle, all students should do so from the curb side of the vehicle, as well, to ensure the safety of our students.
- 6. For drop off and pick up, once students have safely entered or exited a vehicle in the drop off/pick up zone, that vehicle may carefully and safely pass other idle vehicles on the left and then proceed slowly to the exit on Eastern Avenue. Please be very careful and aware of other vehicles and students when passing idle vehicles on the left.
