## How It Works:

Instead of bringing your reading log into the Library, we ask that you keep track and home, and fill out the form at [cslibrary.org/LogMyMinutes](http://cslibrary.org/LogMyMinutes) when you've reached a 300 minute milestone.

### Step 1:

Print out the log at home.

### Step 2:

Mark off a box for each 10 minutes you read.

### Step 3:

When you've reached a prize milestone (300 and 600 minutes), fill out the minute log at [cslibrary.org/LogMyMinutes](http://cslibrary.org/LogMyMinutes). We'll be in touch after July 6 to arrange for you to pick up your books.
