Recorded on worksheets as a result of the small group work activity Community Engagement Session #5 • November 9, 2022

On November 9, 2022 Unite U-46 held a small-group work session to discuss refining and finalizing the Unite U-46 recommendations. Task 1: Did We Get It Right? - Help Us Cross The Finish Line!

- 1. Lack of preschool model that is feasible for working parents w/preschool centers w/dedicated age-appropriate facilities and staffing.
- Buildings need to be built with classrooms that can handle 45 students due to teacher shortage. Solar
 power to support energy needs of 1:1 technology. This would also improve community emergency
 preparedness.

Task 2: Trust and Transparency

- Need more community engagement and transparency on boundary changes.
- Need for a LONG TERM financial and facilities plan that will ensure we do a major rebuild/remodel/new construction w/existing budget every 2-3 years.
- Need for more details on funding distribution per pupil, per school, how we will staff these facilities, etc.
- Need more transparency on what other financial news the district can expect in the next 10-30 years.
- Have we even finished paying off Illinois Park yet? It was just built in 1999.
- Need to get principal buy-in and get them to promote the plans.

Task 2: Trust and Transparency

- Keep parents informed over communication is better than nothing or not enough.
- Keeping the parents informed right away versus waiting until an investigation has took in place or until our children come home and tell us what took place. Send out emails and phone calls right away about any incident that takes place at the school that could affect any of our children.
