



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- On May 6, U-46 administration presented boundary recommendations to the Board of Education for the new middle school in Bartlett
 - At former Hawk Hollow Elementary site
 - Scheduled for occupancy in August 2025

Board will vote on May 20 whether to approve these recommendations

Boundary Guidelines and Criteria Prioritized by the U-46 Community

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
- Distance and travel times to school
- Consistent feeder patterns
- Proximity to schools and keeping communities together
- Ability of siblings to stay at the same school
- Stability of attendance boundaries.
 Avoid changes in two consecutive years.


Location Of New Middle School In Bartlett






Current Middle School Boundaries






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Current Middle School Boundaries for Bartlett Area






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Recommended Boundary Map For New Middle School in Bartlett










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Current Development Projects in the Village


