Here are some general housekeeping tips:

- Just a reminder that U-46 will provide all required school supplies for students in PreK through 6th grade for the 2021-22 school year. We'll have those school supplies ready for students on the first day of school.
- We will not be asking students/guardians to self certify this school year as we did last year. We will be
 practicing social distancing and requiring all students and staff to wear a mask indoors regardless of
 vaccination status. Superintendent Tony Sanders will continue to provide updates on requirements
 around student masking and other safety measures.

- The District's website is also where you'll find the <u>official calendar</u> for the 2021-22 school year, including important dates like winter break, school holidays, and the last day of school (May 31, 2022, if no emergency days are used).

- Teacher assignments for the 2021-2022 school year will be able to be viewed in Infinite Campus on the <u>Parent Portal</u> beginning on Wednesday, August 11th.
- Students entering Preschool/Early Childhood, kindergarten, 6th, 9th and 12th grade are required to submit health records to school on or before the first day of school. For more information, please visit the District's Health Services Department section.
- Arrival-dismissal information will be sent out to families next week.

Finally, we recommend that you make time for a conversation with your children before August 16th about how they feel about the new school year. We recognize that students have faced social, emotional, and academic challenges since the pandemic began. Talking about their hopes and concerns - and your family's own expectations and school-year routines -- can help everyone start off the year with a positive attitude.
