

Back to School in U-46



In late July, after a thorough study of state and federal health and education guidance, and surveys of our staff and families, School District U-46 announced all students would begin the 2020-21 school year remotely. This is not the way we - or anyone in education - wants to start a school year. Educators, parents and students mourn the loss of time together in the classroom, cafeteria and on the school playground. At the same time, we remain dedicated to providing the highest quality instruction and social-emotional support in the safest manner possible during the COVID-19 pandemic. Together, we will journey forward.

The District will re-open for teaching and learning on **Monday, August 24**, implementing our Distance Learning Program for our K-12th grade students before launching similar programming for our preschoolers a week later, on August 31.

News for U-46 Students & Families

For the second quarter, October 26 to January 15, students in grades K-8 can either continue with only the Distance Learning Program through their home school or participate in a hybrid of our Distance Learning and in-person instruction. All high school students will continue with Distance

Glossary

Canvas - The U-46 Learning Management System where teachers will be posting and organizing information for their courses. Teachers can post videos, course content, and lessons, and students can access and submit their curriculum assignments. Canvas also provides a way for teachers, parents and students to directly communicate with each other through live online video, similar to Zoom and Google Meet.

Asynchronous instruction - this term refers to teaching and learning that does not occur in the same place or at the same time. Students during these periods might watch a recorded instructional session and complete exercises or may follow written



High School Instructional Schedule


- 8 Period Day
- Day A: synchronous instructional periods 1, 2, 5, 6
- Day B: synchronous instructional periods 3, 4, 7, 8
- 2 hours 40 minutes of direct instruction per day
- Office hours and support provided before, after and during the school day (asynchronous periods)
- SEL focus to begin the year

- Teachers will participate in weekly 30-minute department meetings
- Teachers will hold 180 minutes of office hours per week outside of the school day. Office hours will be communicated in Canvas and on the school website.

Distance Learning and Hybrid Learning

- Students will be enrolled in Distance Learning or Hybrid Learning at their site
- Curriculum and resources are the same for both models
- Instructional strategies will vary based on the model to support optimal transference of skills and understanding
- Families will receive communication from sites to confirm student selection for 2nd quarter. If no selection is submitted, student will continue in Distance Learning.
- Distance Learning schedule will be updated if necessary and communicated by October 12, 2020
- Hybrid Learning schedule will be communicated by October 12, 2020

Distance Learning and Hybrid Learning

- Maintain site continuity of instruction and assignment for students and staff


