Yes! Preschool, along with all other District grade levels (K-12) will offer a Distance Learning Program for the first quarter. The first day of preschool is Monday, Aug. 31, and the first quarter ends on Thursday, Oct. 22.

Will there be a full Distance Learning option for preschool students?

Yes. Our Early Learners program is working to develop a full Distance Learning option that meets the developmental needs of our earlier learners. Information about this option will be available in late August.

Will my child receive his/her Individualized Education Plan (IEP) service?

Yes. All children will receive their IEP services either in person or online.

Will I be able to meet my child's teacher?

Yes. Instead of offering our traditional in-person home visits, preschool families should expect to have an individual, virtual parent/teacher visit the week Aug. 24. Face-to-face meetings may be planned during the school year as needed and will follow all state and District health requirements and protocol.

Will my child be expected to be on a computer all day?

The Early Childhood department is developing a Distance Learning Program that incorporates a variety of asynchronous activities that include both technology and interaction with their caregiver without the use of technology in addition to the live synchronous time with the teacher.
