



What is an Operating System?



An operating system is the essential software a computer needs to run.
 Without an operating system, your computer is unusable.
 The operating system is what makes a Chromebook different from a Windows laptop, or an iPhone different from an Android phone.

Windows Laptop Overview




- Runs the Windows operating system
- Can install U-46 approved applications
- Is not used by U-46 students during Distance Learning

Chromebook Overview




- Runs the Chrome OS operating system
- Can install limited applications via the Chrome browser
 - Student Chromebooks can only install U-46 approved applications
- Is used by students in 1st-12th grade during Distance Learning at U-46



What is a browser?

 A browser is an application that allows you to browse the internet. The most popular browser is Google Chrome, followed by Safari, Firefox and Edge.



Chromebook Hardware Issues

- Won't power on
- Broken keyboard or missing keys
- Broken ports or buttons
- Touchpad not working
- Sound issues


This does **NOT** include:

- Runs the iPadOS operating system
- Can install applications via the U-46 Catalog app
- Is used by Pre-K and Kindergarten students during distance learning at U-46
 - \circ Only U-46 approved applications can be downloaded from the Catalog app

PreK-6th Grade Students Password Never Expires Can Not Reset Their Own Password



Elementary Students

Teachers, Parents, and Guardians Can View Password, But Cannot Reset It



Secondary Students

7th-12th Grade Students Password Expires After 120 Days Student Can Reset Their Own Password

- On District Wifi
- Off District Wifi
 - Email: <u>passwordresetonly@u-46.org</u>
 - Include:

 - Student date of birth
 - Home address
 - Secondary email address so that your temp password can be sent to you once reset
 - Student ID#
