**Q: Will band and orchestra be offered to 5th and 6th grade students this year?**

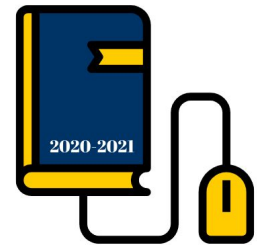
A: Yes! Lessons will be scheduled during the school day. Teachers will communicate directly with students and families about how they can join the music!
