Due to COVID-19, our preschool program will run based on the Illinois plan and if schools are able to operate as normal next school year. Please do not include money with the application form. Upon acceptance, you will receive more information detailing parent orientation, date and times of preschool as well as registration fees and payment procedure.

Enrollment:

As an integral part of the Family and Consumer Sciences curriculum, the Advanced Childhood Education course is designed to provide a lab setting for the enrolled high school students. Preschool children may participate in the program 3 days a week. Preschoolers MUST be potty trained by the first day of preschool as well as be in the appropriate age range (ages 3-5) for acceptance into the preschool program. A current medical form must be filled out by the child's doctor and be submitted by the first day of preschool.

Fees:

The preschool program fee is \$200 for the school year. This fee covers supplies for the children during the year. Payments can be provided directly to me. If paid at the main office, please enter the building at door 3 and pay at the registrar office near the main office. This fee is non-refundable once the preschool year has begun. If payment is divided into two, the initial payment of \$100 must be paid by the first day of preschool, and the second payment would then be due after winter break.

Schedule:

Our preschool schedule varies from the u-46 calendar. Our preschool program does not start until late September/early October and ends in mid May. Our program admittance is first come first serve with limited spots available. Please be advised that our preschool program must adapt to the flexible nature of the high school schedule; therefore, cancellations and/or changes in the daily schedule may occur. We will inform you as far in advance as possible.
