## Principal Notes

Rigor walks are occurring throughout our district each week. Often I complete Rigor walks by myself but this week I had the pleasure of walking Hawk Hollow with Mr. Sanders, Mr. Lindholm, and Dr. Bunker. We walked through six classrooms together and all three gentlemen had wonderful things to say about the instruction occurring in our rooms.

Our teachers are engaged in writing learning targets and referring back to those targets throughout their instruction. In addition, students are working more and more frequently with their academic teams. It's so wonderful to hear the conversations our students are having with one another. In one first grade classroom, the students were engaged in conversations about writing. They encouraged their peers by saying things like "Can you think of anything else?" or "Do you want to think of the last one?" or "We need one more idea.". Conversations like this are occurring every day in our building in all different settings. Students are learning skills to work with one another, critique each other's thinking, and challenge one another academically. These skills help to build character and resilience.

### December 1st - Dental Clinic

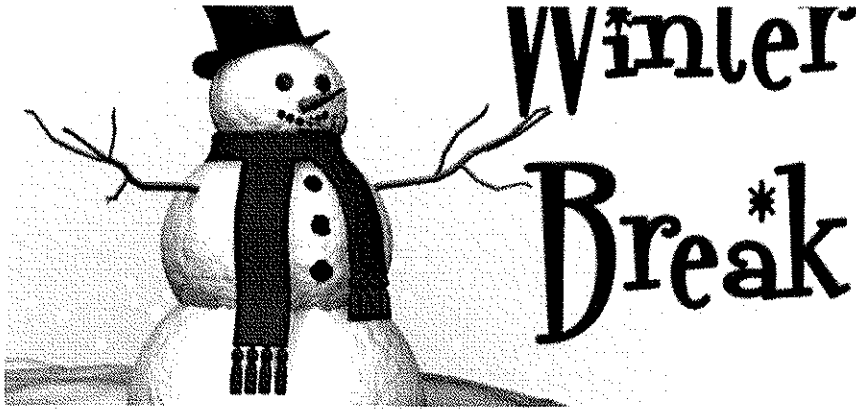
The dental clinic will be in the building today seeing students who signed up for a cleaning.

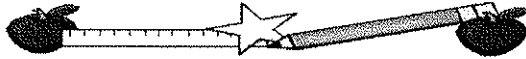
