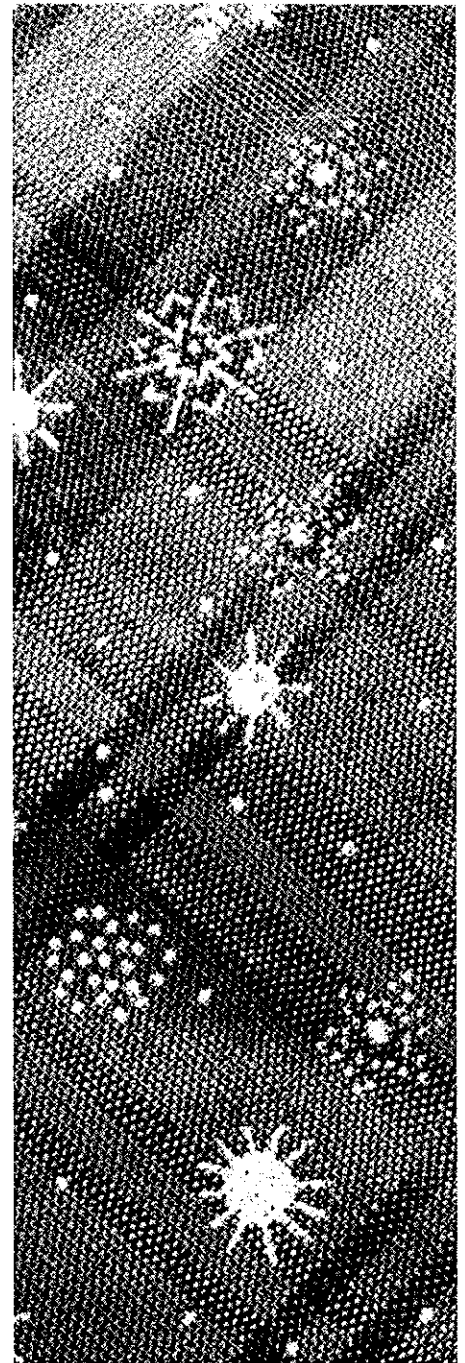
New and Exciting News

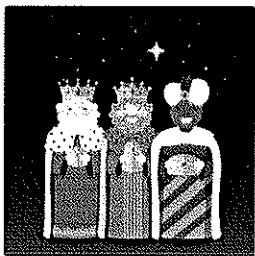

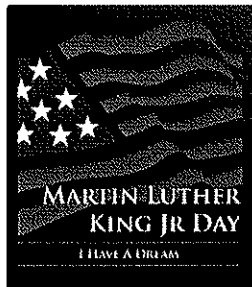

Attention Kindergarten through Sixth Grade Parents

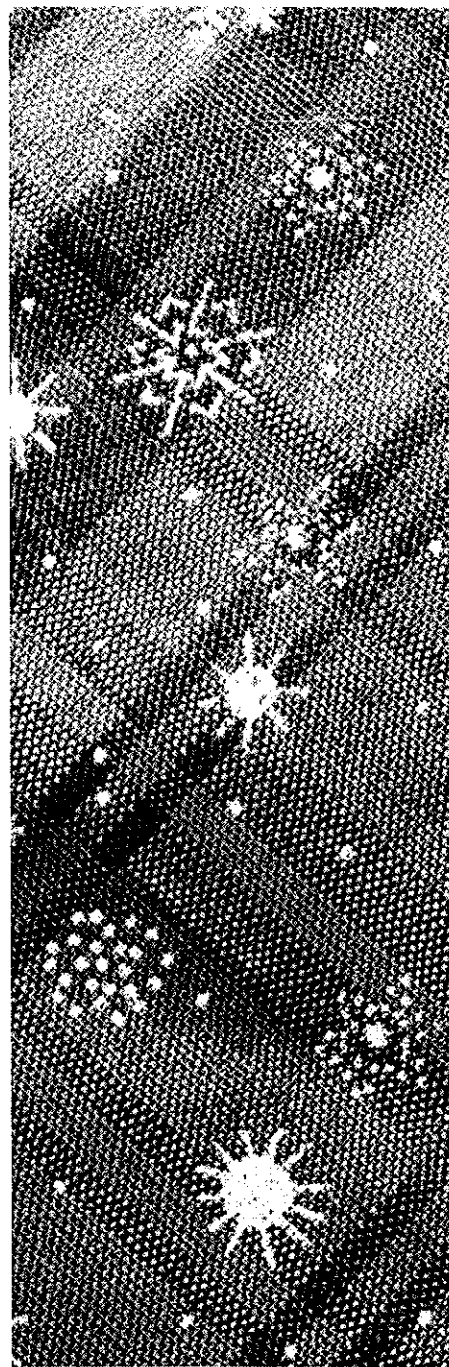
