Car Rider Pick-Up Procedures

Recently, we have received some complaints regarding individuals who are picking their children up from school. Please understand we have protocols in place for the welfare and safety of students and families. We are asking that all parents kindly adhere to the protocols to ensure everyone picking their children up has an opportunity to do it safely.

Please note....our pick up line is using 10-15 minutes long. Sit back, relax, and listen to 4 or 5 great songs on the radio! I mean who doesn't LOVE to sing in their car!!!!!

The protocols are as follows:

- Unless prearranged with Mrs. Dupuis, the three parking spaces towards the far side of the lot are
 not to be used during dismissal. Our staff reserves these spots for parents that have a
 prearranged need or cars asked by staff to pull in those spots if we are locating a child. We don't
 want to hold up the line or block the flow of traffic with individuals pulling out of parking spaces.
- All cars should pull all the way through the line and pull close to the car in front of them. We don't
 want to block traffic out on Gerber Rd.
- · Students should enter the cars on the passenger side to ensure safety.
- Parents should always remain in their cars. If your child needs assistance, just roll down your
 window and give a little shout! We have great staff who would happily assist your child with the
 door!
- Please do not pull out of the line unless a staff member guides your car. This could potentially
 end in an accident if we aren't careful. Our staff will kindly help assist you if you need to pull out
 of line by directing the traffic.
- Remember on COLD days (feels like 15 or lower) our staff will likely line students up in the gym and call out them by their numbers.

Students can pay 15 Feather Bucks to wear their hat or hoodie throughout the school day.


