# UPCOMING ASSESSMENTS AND STUDENT SURVEY

March 21st - March 25th: All students in grades 4-12 will be engaging in the Panorama Equity Survey this week. Students will receive a link in their email on March 21st regarding the survey. Teachers will carve out 15-20 minutes of time during their day to allow students to take the Equity Survey. All information collected from the survey is strictly CONFIDENTIAL so students feel comfortable responding honestly about their experiences in School District U-46.

March 22nd - April 22nd: Fitness gram testing in grades 3 through 6. This will occur during normal physical education classes.

April 4th - April 29th: Illinois Assessment of Readiness for students in grades 3 through 6. WE have not yet secured the dates for this testing. Hawk Hollow students will be engaged in three sessions of math and four sessions of literacy this year. There are some practice tests students can engage in to prepare for the assessment. 


