Student Spotlight

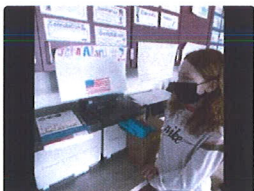

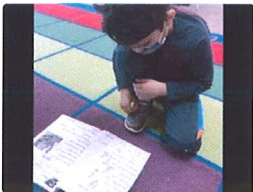

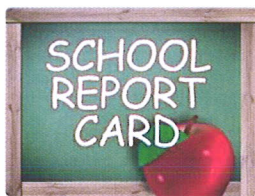

This time of year can be a challenge for many of our Hawk Hollow scholars. Please check in with your student and remind them to be safe, respectful, and responsible in all of their classes.

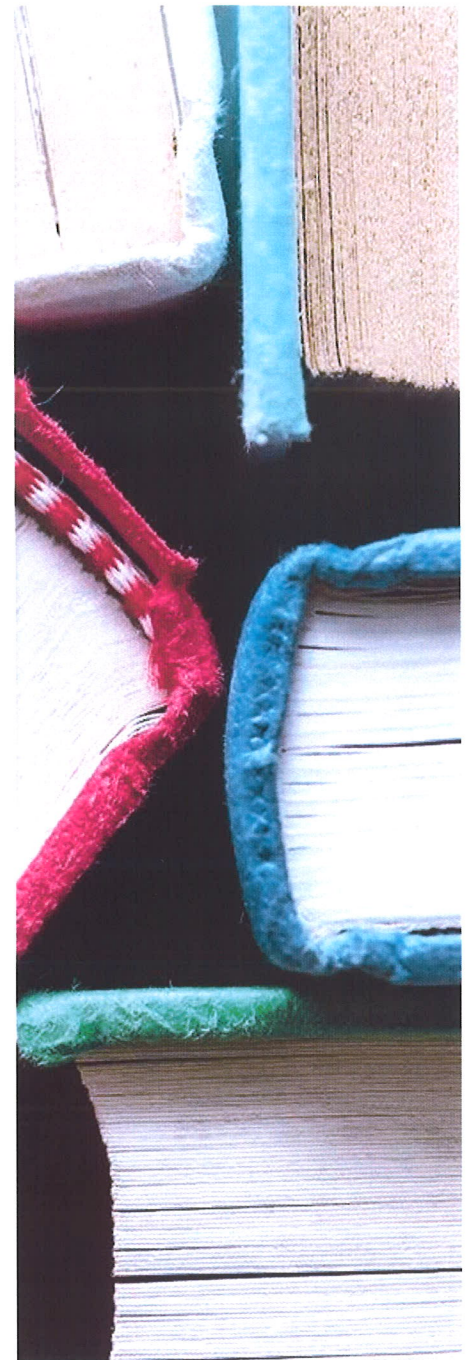

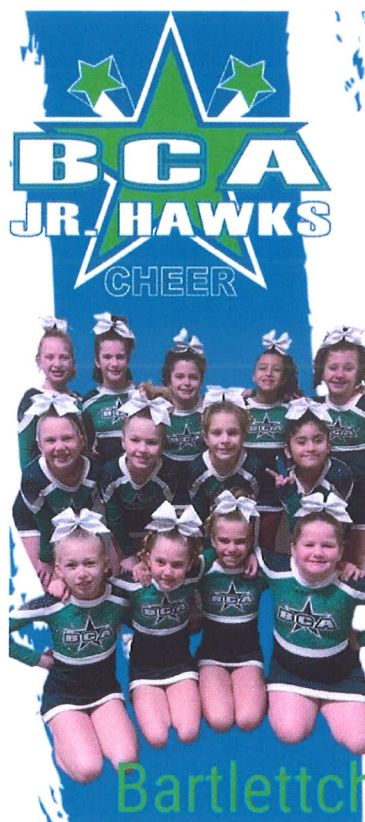
Clase de Música
