Welcome to Our Elementary School Cafeteria

We would like to invite students to participate in our school meal program. There are various ways for you to see the school breakfast/lunch menus. Each month menus are printed and sent home with students. They are available on the district website and are posted in the school cafeteria for all students and parents to view. Breakfasts and lunch is served daily in your school. Free or reduced rates for income-eligible families is available. Please go to the district website at U-46.org to apply. You will be notified of your status after the application has been processed.

Prices for the 2018-2019 school year are as follows:

Breakfast: Full Price - \$1.35 Reduced Price - \$0.30

Lunch: Full Price - \$2.90 Reduced Price - \$0.40

Milk Only Price - \$0.50 (If a student purchases a meal, milk is included in the cost.

This charge is if a student buys ONLY milk).

How Can I Pay for My Child's Meals?

There are various options for you to use to pay for your child's meals. You can send in money to pre-pay for meals on a weekly or monthly basis or you may send in money on the day your child will be eating. All monies sent in will be put on your student's meal account. As they purchase meals, milk, or snacks the account is charged. In Options 1 and 2 your child will bring the payment into school and give it to their classroom teacher. Here are the ways you can pay:

Option 1 – Send in cash. Write your child's name and teacher's name on an envelope. Label the envelope "SCHOOL LUNCH".

Option 2 – Send in a check. Make check payable to YOUR SCHOOL'S CAFETERIA'S NAME

(not U-46). Put the student's school ID number on the check. (If you don't know your student's id # you can contact your school office for the number. Write your student's full name on the memo line. Please include your phone number on the check.

Option 3 – You can log in online to www.MyPaymentsPlus.com to pay with a credit card/check. There is a small fee per transaction for this convenience. It could take 24-36 hours for the money to reach the student's account using this option. This service is not controlled by our district but is linked to our cafeteria software.

The Food Service Department is available for any questions you may have. We encourage all students to participate in our breakfast/lunch program. Your staff at your school cafeteria is eager to serve your student.

Bienvenido a nuestra cafetería de la Escuela Primaria

Nos gustaría invitar a los estudiantes a participar en nuestro programa de comidas escolares. Hay varias maneras para que usted vea los menús de desayuno/almuerzo de la escuela. Cada mes los menús son impresos y enviados a casa con los estudiantes. Están disponibles en el sitio web del distrito y se publican en la cafetería de la escuela para todos los estudiantes y los padres para ver. El desayuno y el almuerzo se sirven diariamente en su escuela. Tarifas gratuitas o reducidas para familias con ingresos elegibles están disponibles. Por favor vaya al sitio web del distrito al U-46.org para solicitar. Se le notificará de su estado después de que la solicitud haya sido procesada.

Los precios para el año escolar 2018-2019 son los siguientes:

Desayuno: precio completo - \$1.35	precio reducido - \$0.30
Almuerzo: precio completo - \$2.90	precio reducido - \$0.40

Precio de la leche solamente - \$0.50 (Si el estudiante compra una comida, la leche está incluida en el costo. Este cargo es si el estudiante compra solamente leche).

¿Cómo puedo pagar las comidas de mi hijo?

Hay varias opciones que usar para pagar las comidas de su hijo. Usted puede enviar dinero para pre-pagar las comidas en una base semanal o mensual o puede enviar dinero el día que su hijo estará comiendo. Todos los fondos enviados serán puestos en la cuenta de comida de su estudiante. A medida que su hijo compra comidas, leche o bocadillos, se cobra la cuenta. En las opciones 1 y 2 su hijo traerá el pago a la escuela y se lo dará a su maestro de clase. Aquí están las maneras que usted puede pagar:

Opción 1 – Enviar en dinero efectivo. Escriba el nombre de su hijo y el nombre del maestro en un sobre. Escriba en el sobre “ALMUERZO ESCOLAR”

Opción 2 – Envía un cheque. Haga el cheque pagadero al nombre de la cafetería de su escuela. (No U-46) Ponga el número de identificación de la escuela del estudiante en el cheque. (Si no conoce el número de identificación de su estudiante, puede ponerse en contacto con la oficina de la escuela para obtener el número.) Escriba el nombre completo de su estudiante en la línea de memo. Por favor incluya su número de teléfono en el cheque.

Opción 3 – Puede conectarse en línea a www.MyPaymentsPlus.com para pagar con una tarjeta de crédito/cheque. Hay una pequeña tarifa por transacción por esta conveniencia. Puede tomar 24-36 horas para que el dinero llegue a la cuenta del estudiante usando esta opción. Este servicio no está controlado por nuestro distrito, pero está vinculado a nuestro software de cafetería.

El Departamento de Servicio de Alimentos es está disponible para cualquier pregunta que usted pueda tener. Animamos a todos los estudiantes a participar en nuestro programa de desayuno/almuerzo. Su personal en la cafetería de su escuela está ansioso por servir a su estudiante.
