## PBIS Skills

## Notes from the Nurses Office

We have seen an increase this past week in absences. Here are some guidelines/information to help keep our student healthy.

### Flu Symptoms

Influenza (also known as flu) is a contagious respiratory illness caused by flu viruses. It can cause mild to severe illness. Flu is different from a cold. Flu usually comes on suddenly. People who are sick with the flu often feel some or all these symptoms. If you suspect your child may have the flu, contact your family doctor.

- Fever or feeling feverish/chills (It is important to note that not everyone with flu will have a fever)
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Runny or stuffy nose
- Muscle or body aches
- Fatigue (tiredness)
- Some people may have vomiting or diarrhea, this is more common in children than adults

**\*\*Students should stay home until fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications and are able to fully participate in school activities.\*\***

### Stomach "Bugs"

Gastrointestinal illness often caused by norovirus, stomach "flu" or "bug" is highly contagious. Prevention includes frequent hand washing and cleaning contaminated surfaces.

**\*\*Students should stay home for a minimum of 24 hours after vomiting, diarrhea and/or fever stops. They should be able to tolerate normal meals before returning to school..**

Please remember to call the attendance line when your student will be absent. When you call, always include the following:

- Your student's symptoms: fever with temperature reading, cough, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea, etc.
- Diagnosis of influenza, virus, respiratory illness, gastrointestinal illness, strep throat, pink eye, etc.

**\*\*If your student is home ill or sent home ill – they need to stay home that day and therefore cannot participate in after school or evening programs or events \*\***
