Notes from the Nurse

Welcome back! I hope everyone had a restful, fun summer. Below is important information pertaining to the health of all students.

- All Kindergarten and 6th graders are required to have updated physical exams and immunizations complete by the first day of school. The student will not be able to start school until these requirements are met.
- Any student requiring medication at school needs to have a
 Medication Permission Form filled out by the doctor and parent.
 Medications need to be dropped off at school by an adult along with
 the required paperwork. The only exception to this in inhalers —
 students can bring in their inhalers. All inhalers are kept in the nurse's
 office.
- If your child has any health condition (asthma, allergies, seizures)
 please let the nurse know.
- We ask that students do not bring snacks that contain peanuts for their morning classroom snack. Students are allowed to bring food with peanuts for lunch. If you wish to send a treat for your student's birthday, it should be a non-edible treat (sticker, pencil, etc.).
- Physical Exams/Immunization Records/Medication Forms may be dropped off in the Main Office beginning August 1st or faxed or emailed to me.

Friday, August 9th: 10:30 am -2:30 pm

Monday, August 12th: 7:00 am – 1:30 pm, 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm

Tuesday, August 13th: 7:00 am - 1:30 pm
