Dismissal and Car Rider Procedures

Our school day ends at 2:30 and at this time, students will begin exiting the school to head home. We have specific doors the kids will exit for cars, buses, or as a walker.

- Bus Students exit Door 5
- Car riders exit the Main Doors
- Walkers exit Door 3

If you are walking home with your child please head to Door 3 near Mrs. Liner's Kindergarten classroom.

If your child is a car rider please make sure to get a car rider tag from the office and display it in your automobile. Our car rider line typically takes 15 minutes from dismissal until our last student leaves. We ask that you respect each other and stay in your car during this process. We thank you for your cooperation.

School Improvement Goals for Hawk Hollow Elementary

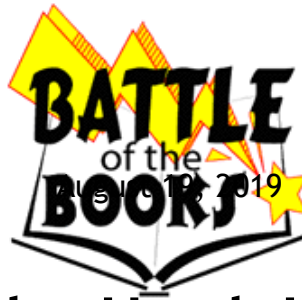

Join the Hawk Hollow Battle of the Books Team!

Battle of the Books (BOB) is a program for 4th, 5th and 6th grade students. It is a contest that has as its purpose the encouragement of quality reading. It is offered jointly by Bartlett Public Library, Gail Borden Public Library and Poplar Creek Public Library. Team members read books from a list of books chosen by librarians. Books include fiction, nonfiction and picture books. At a battle, teams could be questioned on any one of the books on the BOB book list. Scores are kept and winners are recognized; however, much emphasis throughout the season is placed on the fun of participation and the satisfaction that comes from reading and from starting and finishing an assignment.

- Season runs August through March.
- Books may be checked out from the Hawk Hollow Library, any other public library or purchased by the team member's family.
- There is no additional cost for this program.
- Our team will meet once per week to review sample questions and book strategies in the Hawk Hollow Library every Thursday 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm
- **Our first meeting will be held on Thursday August 29 in the Hawk Hollow Library 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm.**
- Battles occur monthly and will be held on either Tuesdays or Thursdays at any one of the following locations: Gail Borden Public Library in Elgin, Poplar Creek Library in Streamwood or Bartlett Public Library in Bartlett. There are 6 Battles October through March.
- We will publish the Battle Schedule as soon as it is available. Team members must arrive at the battle location by 3:00 pm and they are generally over by 4:15 pm.
- Parents are responsible for team members transportation to and from meetings and battles.

Please discuss BOB with your student and consider joining this wonderful reading program. **If you decide to participate, please complete the attached permission form and return it to the school office by Monday August 26, 2019.**
