School Safety



On September 27th, 2018, the district ran a surprise security check on our building. During the compliance district personnel takes note of five indicators:

1. Doors Locked - Are the exterior doors locked during the school day?
2. Inquiry - Does office staff use the intercom system to inquiry the name and nature of business the visitor has with the school?
3. Greeting Time - After entry, the intern is directed not to go to the office, but to wander slowly away from the office down the school hallway. Does the office staff direct the visitor back to the office within 30 seconds?
4. Sign In - does the front office staff use the Raptor system for visitor sign in?
5. Visitor Tag - does the front office staff use the Raptor name tag for visitors?
