

Legal Framework ISBE 23 Article 228.30 of

Illinois School Code "Each district shall establish a parent advisory committee (BPAC) consisting of:

- parents
- legal guardians
- transitional bilingual education teachers
- counselors
- community leaders

This committee shall participate in the planning, operation, and evaluation of programs. The majority of the committee members shall be parents or legal guardians of students enrolled in these programs.

Membership on this committee shall be representative of the languages served in programs to the extent possible."
