Hanover Township Welfare Services is committed to improving the welfare of Hanover Township residents experiencing hardships. Providing resources and support empowering residents in achieving self sustainability; to serve promptly with dignity and respect. For qualifying residents' cash assistance programs include:

General Assistance which provides monthly financial assistance to persons not eligible for any other state or federal assistance programs and who do not have adequate income or resources to provide for their own basic need, and

Emergency Assistance for residents in life-threatening situations who have no income for 30 days. Residents can only qualify once every 18 months.

We have established strong networking relationships with many other Suburban Cook County agencies so we may better connect our residents with information and referrals.

Listed below are some additional services we provide:

L.I.H.E.A.P.Intake Site (cook county residents): the program is designed to assist eligible low-income households pay for winter energy services.

Weatherization Intake Site: the program focuses on making homes safer and more energy efficient for qualifying low income residents in Cook County.

ComEd Residential Special Hardship Program: runs January 1st until funds are depleted. The program provides a one-time grant up to \$500 for customers who qualify.

Food Pantry: The Hanover Township Food Pantry is open to help residents that are experiencing hardships with food. We also have referrals for help with pet food.

All Kids intake site: the All Kids program offers Illinois uninsured children comprehensive healthcare. Parents may have to pay a monthly premium depending on household income.

Safelink wireless Applications: is a government sponsored program that provides a free cell phone and air time use to income eligible customers.

After school snack program: The Hanover Township Astor Avenue Community Center hosts a free healthy snack Monday through Friday from 2:30pm to 3:30pm. The snacks are donated from the Northern Illinois Food Bank.

Community Health Nurse: Our Community Health department offers free health screenings every Wednesday at the Astor Avenue Community Center. Free screenings include diabetes, anemia, blood pressure, health education and medication review, cholesterol (service fee may apply).

IL Department of Human Services: applications for the snap (food stamp) program, cash & medical assistance are available in our office.
