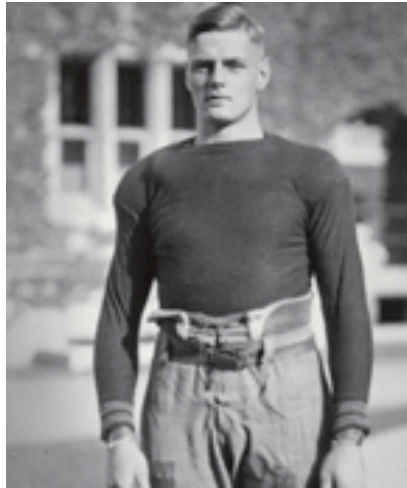


August W. “Gus” Farwick Biography

In his three years as a lineman on Elgin High School grid teams(1918—20), Gus Farwick helped those teams compile an impressive 15—6—2 record that included holding opponents to an average of less than 7 points a game.

A lineman on Army elevens at West Point, he received All-American Mention in 1923 and 1924 and played in the first ever East-West Shrine game. Gus was an assistant coach at West Point in 1926-27 and was head football coach at the University of Arizona in 1932—33.
