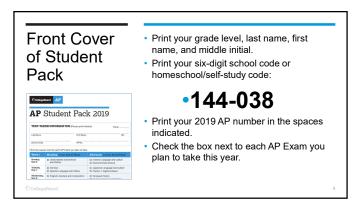

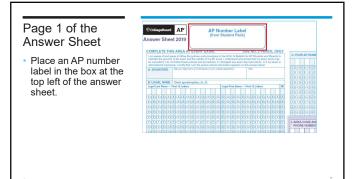
Write your name on the upper right corner of the sheet of AP number labels in the center of the Student Pack.

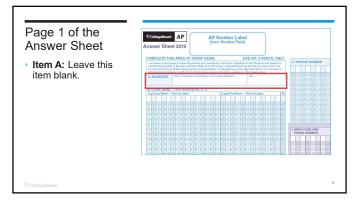
Place one label on the back cover of the Student Pack in the top left corner of the College Information Card.

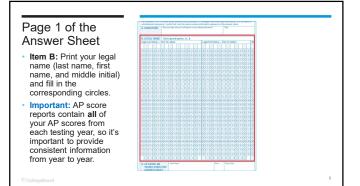

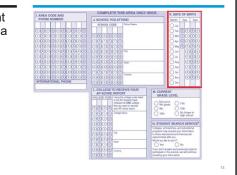
- In Item J, print the school code (or homeschool/self-study code) you printed on the front of your Student Pack and fill in the circles: 144038

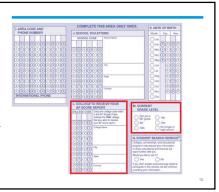



- In Item Q, print your complete mailing address, including the ZIP or postal code. Print your country code only if you do not have a U.S. ZIP or postal code. Fill in the circles. Be sure to fill in a circle for State.
- Complete Item R only if you are outside the United States and your full address does not fit in Item Q.
