Booster Club Scholarships

The Bartlett High School (BHS) Booster Club will be awarding two (2) scholarships, in the amount of \$1,000 each, for the 2021/2022 school year. These are a one-time, non-renewable award to be presented in 2022.

To be considered for this scholarship, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Applicant's family must be a member in good standing of the BHS Booster Club for the 2021/2022 membership year (see www.bhsboosters.org). Applicant must be a BHS senior graduating in 2022.
2. Applicant must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better.
3. Applicant will be attending a 2 or 4 year college or university, technical school, vocational school, or trade school following graduation from BHS.
4. Applicant cannot be a recipient of an NCAA Division I scholarship.
5. Applicant must have been an active member during the 2021/2022 school year in one of the BHS Booster Club supported activities.

Please complete the following items and ensure they are submitted to the Bartlett High School Guidance Office no later than April 18th, 2022:

1. Applicant must complete the **BHS Local Scholarship Application Form**.
2. Applicant must write a **one page essay** (with double spaced lines) describing what being in a sport, club, or organization at BHS has meant to him/her and include this with the completed application.
3. Applicant must use the **BHS Booster Club Scholarship Recommendation Form** and request **two** recommendations, one from a teacher familiar with his/her academic abilities and the other by a coach or activity sponsor. Each completed recommendation should be sealed in an envelope (with signature across the seal) and **returned to the applicant**. This must then be turned in with your scholarship application by the April 18th, 2022 deadline. *Ideally the applicant should provide an envelope with the recommendation form.*

Fine Arts Scholarship

The Fine Arts Scholarship is a one-year, non-renewable award of \$500.00 awarded to up to three Bartlett High School graduate(s) who participated in studies and activities in the Fine Arts programs within Bartlett High School and the community. Student(s) receiving this award will continue their studies through participation in the Fine Arts program(s) at a two- or four-year college or university, or at a school or conservatory providing studies in the Arts.

In addition to completing the Bartlett High School Common Scholarship Application form, students applying for the Fine Arts Scholarship also need to submit:

- The area of Fine Arts in which you plan to major, minor, or participate in during your post-high school studies
- A list of your extracurricular activities in high school and the community
- Volunteer work performed for the Fine Arts departments at the high school
- Any Fine Arts recognition or awards received
- A list of Fine Arts courses completed in high school, along with semester grades through your 7th semester
- Verification of acceptance to the college or university of your choice (If you have not yet made your college choice, include acceptances to all colleges you are still considering)
- Two letters of recommendation (not the Booster Club Scholarship Recommendation Form), one being from a Fine Arts teacher and one being from another source
- A personal statement of how participation in Fine Arts has impacted your life
- Any other information you would like the scholarship committee to have as they review your application

As a recipient of this award I understand that:

- ❖ I will attend a four-year college or university, or a two-year community college.
- ❖ My college of choice has a French studies program, and I will provide proof that I am currently continuing my French education (first semester transcript) before dispersal of funds takes place.
- ❖ I have also maintained an A average throughout my senior year at BHS.
- ❖ There will be one (1) scholarship awarded, worth \$500.00. Additional scholarships may be added at the discretion of Ms. Sauer and the funds available.
- ❖ The deadline to submit the application is Monday, April 18th, 2022. Applications submitted late will be disqualified. All applications must be submitted directly to Ms. Sauer.
- ❖ Winners must attend the Senior Recognition Ceremony in May to receive the scholarship certificate. Failure to attend could result in forfeiture of the scholarship award.
- ❖ The Senior Scholarship Application form must be completed in your best French. Responses to the essay questions must be typed and double-spaced.

HOSA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

Amount of Scholarship: \$500

The criteria for the NHS Scholarship is as follows:

- Two (2) year membership in N.H.S.
- A copy of your service log, in typed format, with emphasis on N.H.S. service
- Description of NHS Service Project and why it was important to you
- Three (3) letters of recommendation, either from teachers or volunteer supervisors, supporting why you are deserving of this scholarship
- 300 word essay explaining as to why you feel deserving of this particular award

Student Council Scholarship

A \$400 scholarship will be awarded to the student who has demonstrated a dedication to Student Council and increasing school spirit. To apply, the student must have been a member of Student Council for a minimum of two years, and have at least a 90% attendance rate at mandatory meetings and events. Leadership roles will be taken into consideration, but are not required.

Please provide a statement describing in detail your involvement as a Student Council member. Include in that statement the number of years you have been in Student Council.

Attach an essay telling why you should receive this scholarship, what benefits you expect to gain from a higher education, and any other information that will help us determine who should receive the scholarship. You may attach letters of recommendation if you wish, but they are not required.
