

PHYSICAL EDUCATION EXEMPTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS AGREEMENT

Seven semesters of physical education are required for graduation from U-46 high schools. You are requesting to be exempt from P.E. for the upcoming school year. It is important that you understand and acknowledge the terms conditions which accompany this exemption.

In order for the exemption to be considered:

Students cannot have early release, late arrival or a study hall (besides lunch study) in their schedule.

Juniors must be enrolled in full year graduation requirements and have no previous failures in P.E.

Juniors cannot use a PE exemption for early graduation.

Seniors must be enrolled in full year graduation requirements and have no previous failures in P.E.

If a student selects to drop any of their classes, they will forfeit their P.E. exemption.

5.	Ongoing participation in an interscholastic athletic program (student must be in the 11 th or 12 th grade); only out of P.E. during the athletic program, once program is over student returns to P.E. class.	
4.	If the student must use the time set aside for physical education to receive special education support and services, subject to the student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP).	
3.	Enrollment in academic classes which are required for graduation from high school, provided that failure to take such classes will result in the pupil being unable to graduate (student must be in the 11 th or 12 th grade).	
2.	Enrollment in academic classes which are required for admission to an institution of high learning, provided that failure to take such classes will result in the pupil being denied admission (student must be in the 11 th or 12 th grade). Provide documentation from the College or University and proposed student schedule. **	
1.	Enrollment, for credit, in a marching band program for students in grades $9-12$ (valid for the semester in which there is ongoing participation).
