Please self certify each day before entering school

The Illinois State Board of Education's guidance requires all individuals to self certify that they are free of the symptoms associated with COVID-19 before entering school buildings, facilities, or buses on a daily basis.

Symptoms of Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Know the symptoms of COVID-19, which can include the following:




Symptoms can range from mild to severe illness, and appear 2-14 days after you are exposed to the virus that causes COVID-19.


What happens next?

Each day, a report is generated for all supervisors of the employees who report to that supervisor or to that department.

If **no** symptoms you will see

Supervisors will check in with employees who:

- 1. Indicate having symptoms, or
- Did not complete the self-certify requirement.



You are cleared to go to work.



STOP and do NOT go to work based on your responses for having symptoms of COVID-19. **NOTIFY YOUR SUPERVISOR.**

Visitors - As part of our "new normal" we are asking that all visitors make appointments prior to visiting a District school or facility, even if it is just to drop off an item.




Self Certification - Studen

What happens if I do not complete this?

Each day, a report is generated for all students. This report is sent to the principal and school nurse.

The school nurses and principals will check in with all students who either:

- 1. Indicate having symptoms, or
- Did not complete the self certification requirement.

What if you were exposed to a COVID-19 confirmed case?

If you were exposed to a person confirmed to have COVID-19 within the past 14 days, please do the following:

Parents: If it is your child or someone in your household, please notify your school attendance line or school nurse.

Staff: If it is you or someone in your household, please notify your supervisor.





Within the last 14 days if have you been in close contact (close contact is defined as six feet or less, with or without a mask for an cumulative time of 15 minutes or greater) with a person **confirmed** to have COVID-19 or someone in your household awaiting results of a COVID-19 test, please contact your school nurse if this is about a student or your supervisor if this is a staff member before going to work or school.
