**** We will go on 2 trips. The additional date is given to allow for cancellations due to lack of snow or school called off.

Place: Wilmot Mountain in Wisconsin (www.wilmotmountain.com)

Information:

We will take 2 trips to Wilmot Mt. If you want to become a member, you must commit to both trips. If a trip is canceled, the alternate date will be used. If we do not take 2 trips, 1/2 of the total funds that you paid will be refunded at the end of the season for each trip that is not taken. Once you commit and pay, no money will be refunded if you miss one of the scheduled trips. Consideration for a partial refund will be given only if we still have 20 participants without you and if we receive two weeks notice. Our rates from Wilmot are discounted and based on a minimum of 20 participants. If we do not have the minimum participants signed up by **3:00 PM on Tuesday December 17**, the trips will be canceled and all fees will be returned. If we have less than 20 participants, the cost would be an additional \$10.00 per trip (\$100.00, \$120.00, \$140.00) or the trips will be cancelled. School rules will apply and will be enforced as in all school related trips. Multiple discipline referrals may make you ineligible for the trips.

If you want to become a member, complete the application form signed by you and your parent and turn it in with your payment at the Treasurer's Office. The completed Application with full payment is to be turned into the Treasurer's office by 3:00 PM Tuesday December 17, 2013.

Transportation:

Transportation will be by District U46 school buses. Transportation is to Wilmot Mountain from Streamwood High School and back. Arrangements to be picked up at Streamwood High School must be made so that you will be picked up at 10:30 PM. Your ride <u>must</u> be there when we arrive at 10:30 PM as there will not be any telephones available, the school will be locked and the bus will not stay once we are dropped off. Sponsors <u>cannot</u> and <u>will not</u> provide rides. The bus to Wilmot will leave Streamwood High School around 3:30. Travel time to Wilmot is approximately one hour, but usually takes longer to get there than it does coming home. The bus home to Streamwood High School will leave Wilmot promptly at 9:30 PM. If you rented equipment, you should return it by 9:15 PM. Everyone should report to the bus by 9:20 PM so that attendance can be taken. It is important that these times be adhered to so as to insure our return time of 10:30 PM to Streamwood H.S. Not returning to the bus by 9:20 PM could result in your loss of club membership and the forfeit of part or all of your unused fees paid for the remaining trips. The cost:

You will select from one of the following three plans. The cost for each plan is the <u>total</u> amount for both trips.

Round trip bus transportation, lift ticket and a lesson *This is the option you want if you own your own equipment:	\$80.00
Snowboard or Skis Rentals: Round trip bus transportation, lift ticket, lesson and Ski Rental *Ski rental requires a \$10.00 cash deposit and ID .	\$100.00
Round trip bus transportation, lift ticket, lesson and Snow Board Rental *Snowboard rental requires a photo ID plus \$10.00 cash deposit	\$120.00

Equipment Security:

It is important that you understand that <u>you</u> are responsible for your personal or rented equipment. Locking ski/snowboard racks and lockers are available to secure your equipment. Loss of rented equipment will result in a forfeit of your deposit. Loss of any personal equipment will be at your expense. Wilmot, Streamwood H.S. and its sponsors are not liable for any losses of any kind.

Lessons:

Since lessons are part of what you are paying for with all the plans, it recommended that you take one. If you've never skied/snowboarded, you <u>must</u> take a lesson. This is <u>not</u> an option. Even the most experienced skier/snowboarder can benefit from a lesson. You may learn a trick or two.

All checks are payable to STREAMWOOD HIGH SCHOOL, STREAMWOOD HIGH SCHOOL SKI/SNOWBOARD CLUB.

Once again, the club fees are based a minimum number of 20 participants. Following school rules and regulations, and maintaining the time lines laid out are extremely important to keeping a good standing in the club so as to not forfeit any fees. It would be unfair to punish the whole club because of one (or more) inconsiderate individual(s).

As noted above, if we have less than 20 participants but a minimum of 15, the cost would be an additional \$10.00 per trip or the trips will be cancelled.

For students who bring their equipment to school, you can bring the equipment to the third floor library and I will keep it in the office.

I understand that my son/daughter must report to the bus for the return trip to Streamwood High School by 9:20 or lose the club membership and forfeit part or all of the unused fees paid for remaining trips.

I understand that transportation home from Streamwood High School must be available for my child at 10:30 PM as there will be no telephones available on returning to Streamwood High School and the building will be locked and the sponsors cannot provide any rides.

I understand that Streamwood High School and the club sponsors will not be held liable for any injuries while skiing or for any theft or loss of any personal or rented equipment. Insurance by Wilmot Mountain covers rental equipment only.

I understand that School rules will apply and will be enforced as in all school related trips.

I understand the club fees are based a minimum number of 20. Following school rules and regulations, and maintaining the time lines laid out are extremely important to keeping a good standing in the club so as to not forfeit any fees.

I understand that the club must maintain a minimum number of 20 participants for the trips to take place. I understand that consideration for a partial refund for a missed trip may be given only if the club still has 20 participants without my son/daughter and if we provide two weeks notice to the sponsors. If the ski/snowboard club does not have at least 20 participants signed up by **December 17th**, the trips will be canceled and all fees paid will be returned. If we get a less than 20 but a minimum of 15 students, the trips would still be taken provided the students are willing to pay an additional \$10.00 per trip.
