Enrolling in Drivers Education

1. Students enrolling in Drivers Education (DE) must have a social security number. This is needed in order to obtain a driving permit. If you enroll in the DE class and you do not have a social security number, you will immediately be dropped from the class and reassigned to a study hall.
2. Students must have earned eight (8) credits the prior two semesters in order to enroll in Drivers Education.
3. Students must attend all Behind the Wheel (BTW) driving assignments. On the second (2nd) absence from BTW, the student will be dropped from the class and reassigned to a study hall. The driving requirement is a state of Illinois rule.
4. Students must attend all DE classroom sessions. On the fourth (4th) DE classroom absence, the student will be dropped from DE and reassigned to a study hall. The classroom requirement is a state of Illinois rule.
5. The course fee for Drivers Education is \$300.00. You will pay this fee at registration. If you qualify for Free Lunch, this fee will be waived. If you are dropped from DE for any reason, the fee is not refunded.
6. Students are responsible for the driving permit fee. The fee for the permit is \$20.00. This is due on the day that the student fills out the form for the permit.
7. Students will be loaned a drivers education textbook. If the book is lost, the student will be responsible to replace the book at a cost of \$25.00.
8. Any student with an "A" or a "B" for the driver education class and the BTW portion can qualify to take the final driving test at Streamwood High School instead of the state facility.
9. Students are required to show documentation of an additional 50 hours of driving with a parent, 10 hours must be driving at night.
