- d. Examine the Assessments




Step 2: Find the Ladder - Notice how the lesson builds from simple to complex

- a. Select Must Do, Could Do and Extension problems from the Problem Set
- b. Highlight the Concept Development to include parts for delivery of lesson
 - Materials needed

- c. Select debrief questions
- d. Adjust remaining components
 - Modify Homework to match Must Do
 - Select Fluency
