

"This email is to inform you that IF your student failed a class this semester, the student has the chance this summer (through online classes) to turn the incomplete (I) into a passing grade. Students can take up to 3 classes (if needed).

Please see the details below:

1) 1st Semester failures or acceleration in traditional summer school- students in grades 9-12 who fail a course in the first semester of the 2019-2020 school year or any time previous.

Session 1: June 8 - June 25

Session 2: June 28 - July 17

Fees: \$340/0/0 and \$35 for ELL students per session (*CTE classes Intro to Business, Computer Applications and Accounting are free for all students through the CTE grant*)

Times: 9 am to 2 pm, Monday through Thursday

(2) 2nd Semester Failures/Incompletes (Proficiency Summer School) - students who receive an 'I' or "E" in a 2nd semester class.

Proficiency school will have two methods of curriculum delivery:

a): Tutorials- students will complete standards they are deficient within the APEX program. Students will complete this/these course(s) and this/these grade(s) will replace the 'I' or "E" on their transcript.

There are three session dates available for these courses. Only one tutorial course can be completed per session, but your student could take all 3 sessions. Courses offered within tutorials are below:

English 1, 2, 3, & 4, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, US History, PE, Health, and Biology

Session 1: June 8 - June 19

Session 2: June 22 - July 3

Session 3: July 6 - July 17

Fees: \$100 (for students who pay full price for lunch) per session

\$0 (for students who pay reduced price for lunch) per session

\$0 (for students who have free lunch) per session

Times: Teacher is available from 9 am to 1:30 pm, Monday through Friday

Format: APEX (online) tutorials

b) Traditional Summer School- students will complete these courses within the

traditional summer school (distance learning) format with this grade will replace the 'I' or "E" on their transcript. These courses are only offered during the second semester of summer school.

High School Courses: ALE I, Chemistry, Geology, Econ, Civics and Global business, Computer Applications

Session: June 29-July 17

Fees: \$100 (for students who pay full price for lunch) per session

\$0 (for students who pay reduced price for lunch) per session

\$0 (for students who have free lunch) per session

Times: 9 am to 2 pm, Monday through Thursday

Format: Virtual (online) format (like we are using now for distance learning)

Once you have discussed this with your student, please email the student's school counselor what class(es) you want your student to take (remember you can take up to 3). This will be the only time students can take a summer school class to earn a passing grade for FREE if they have free/reduced lunch or a reduced price of \$100 for students with full price lunch. Deadline is Tuesday, June 2nd @ 3pm.

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
