Participating CTE groups

Precision Manufacturing Internship – Mr. Erbach

- Focus on manufacturing and engineering
- Visits to manufacturing businesses and work on a precision manufacturing project at school
- Should be enrolled in Precision Manufacturing or Project Lead the Way classes

Business Internship – Dr. Thomas

- **6 teams of students** will work with local business owners / project managers on a variety of projects that each organization wants to address.
- **Onsite visits with business owners**
- **Visit to ECC to engage with professors**

- The interview team will select the final students and assign them to a business or precision manufacturing team according to each student's interests and skills.

Students selected for the internship will be required to attend an orientation in March and agree to commit to being in attendance for the internship the entire week of spring break.
