Articulated Credit

School District U-46 has entered into articulated credit agreements with several area community colleges and technical schools. This provides an opportunity for students to earn college credit when they enroll and complete specific high school courses. The high school and the community colleges or technical schools have agreed that the high school courses meet the learning objectives and task competencies of equivalent courses offered by their respective facilities. The student can enroll in the higher postsecondary course for which the high school course is the prerequisite. In order to receive the postsecondary credit for the high school course, the student must earn a grade of B or better and enroll within 2 years of graduation.

This program offers several advantages to the students. First, they do not have to repeat courses for which they already possess the knowledge and skill. Secondly, they can enroll in the more advanced courses offered by the postsecondary institution. Third, there is a significant cost savings to the students and their families because the need to repeat learned course material is eliminated.
