Dear Applicant,

Congratulations! You have been nominated for membership into the South Elgin Chapter of the National Honor Society. You have met the MINIMUM Academic Standard for eligibility. Membership, however, is based on leadership, character, and service, as well as scholarship. The process for selection involves two steps: (1) your name is submitted to the South Elgin faculty who evaluates your leadership and character as well as your scholarship (we take care of this) and (2) you must complete a student activity form (see attached) reflecting service and the Statement of Understanding. Neither the student activity form nor your grade point index guarantees membership. However, if you fail to return the student activity form and the Statement of Understanding by the date below, your candidacy for membership will not be considered.

Faculty evaluations and student activity forms are reviewed by a selection committee comprised of several faculty members. After review, the committee decides which nominees meet criteria for membership. If selected, you will receive an invitation to become a member of the National Honor Society.

Complete section I-IV of the student activity form. Please be detailed and specific. Each piece of information you submit about yourself helps the selection committee make its decision. Include all information you feel is pertinent for a clear perspective of your activities within the school, community and family. If, for some reason, you have not been involved in a wide variety of activities but have concentrated your efforts into a few, be specific as to why. Please type your responses. You and your parents must also sign the <u>Statement of Understanding</u> that verifies your understanding of the selection process, the eligibility requirements, and membership requirements as adopted by South Elgin High School.

Membership requirements are as follows: one meeting a month after school. Meetings are about 15-20 minutes in length and are the first Tuesday of the month after school. Additionally, new juniors are required to obtain 20 hours of service and new seniors 10 hours of service before the end of the school year. Failure to meet these requirements will result in removal from the National Honor Society.

Return your completed student activity form and Statement of Understanding to the folder in the Guidance Office by 3:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, September 10, 2019**. **LATE FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR CONSIDERED**.

**DIRECTIONS:** Please complete section I-III. **DO NOT** be modest! Each piece of information you submit about yourself helps the Faculty Selection Committee make its decisions. Include information you feel is pertinent to provide a clear perspective of your service, leadership, and character. Information should reflect activities within the school, community, and family as well as a contact name and phone number.

If, for some reason, you have not been involved in a wide variety of activities, but have concentrated your efforts into a few, be specific as to why.

**INCLUDE** your name as you have been known by your teachers and indicate your year of graduation. Please attach, if possible, your own typed sheets using the format shown.

By signing, I also indicate that I will accept the decision of the Faculty Council charged with the responsibility of selecting members.
