### School District U-46 SOUTH ELGIN HIGH SCHOOL Student Parking Regulations Agreement

Safe and courteous driving habits are of utmost importance. Compliance with the following regulations is an expectation:

- A current valid student permit is required to park in the SEHS student parking areas.
- Students **must park in their designated student parking numbered space** indicated on their parking tag. Parking in the visitor's lot or another unnumbered space, will result in a \$25 parking ticket. Violations may result in TOWING.
- **If your spot is occupied**, get the license plate of the vehicle, park in staff lot "G" 1<sup>st</sup> semester or staff lot "A" or "G" 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. Leave your tag visibly hanging and *report it to the Dean's Office* to avoid getting a ticket.
- Parking tags are non-transferable and may **NOT be sold**. Only registered vehicles are allowed to use the tag. Tags cannot be shared between two students unless they are siblings who reside at the same address. It is the student or vehicle owner's responsibility to report any change in vehicle or insurance/owner information to the Dean's Office (extension 3649).
- Parking tags must be **visible, facing out**, from the rear view mirror while the vehicle is parked at SEHS.
- Parking lot speed limit is 10 miles per hour.
- Parking fines (tickets) are **\$25**.
- Students are responsible for any item(s) in the vehicle and any person who is allowed to ride with them.
- All vehicles parked on SEHS property are subject to search without notice as stated in the Illinois school code.
- SEHS is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles on school property. Leave items of value at home.
- Sound and/or music may not be amplified or projected more than 75 feet from any vehicle.

# Repeated violations of any of the following will result in disciplinary action, including revocation of parking privileges without refund of fee (Violations can also occur before and after school hours):

Failure to pay any or all parking tickets. *Buying a tag after receiving a ticket does NOT void the ticket*. Reckless driving Speeding Parking in a handicapped spot without a valid handicap permit.

Parking in a nanocapped spot without a valid nanocap permit Parking in fire lanes, staff/faculty lots, or bus loading areas

Failure to comply with SEHS driving, sound and parking rules

Failure to conform to State of Illinois driving laws or regulations

Any violation deemed a safety or health danger to self or others

In addition, a student's conduct on campus may result in their parking privileges being revoked (ex. suspension, repeated assignments to in-school intervention, etc.) For more information, please refer to the U-46 Student Code of Conduct glossary term "Parking Permit Revoked".

A SEHS Dean of Students will contact both the student and their parent/guardian if their parking privileges are revoked.

### Violation of the following will result in <u>TOWING AT OWNER'S EXPENSE</u>:

After receiving 2 tickets, regardless if paid or not, and violations continue, the vehicle will be towed with EACH subsequence occurrence.
