

DRAFT SPEECH SCHEDULE #2 (WHEN THERE IS A MIDWEEK TOURNAMENT)

This **DRAFT** schedule is **subject to changes** based on: Speech auditions (how many students are placed in specific categories); holidays; inclement weather; tournaments that may be scheduled on weeknights instead of weekends; required IHSA State Series Coach Meetings; unexpected mid-to-late-season student category or partner changes; et cetera. Each practice will function like a class; all students in a single category will meet at the same time, “learn the lingo” of Speech criticism, and critique each others’ performances. As the season goes on, students will provide feedback to each other that is near-identical to what judges might write. In sum, students will learn how to coach each other.
