Your child’s freshman year will be here before you know it! In order to best prepare both you and your 8th grader, we are providing you with important information prior to high school orientation and registration.

Bartlett and South Elgin High School are coming to Eastview next month. Both schools will come for **orientation** on **Tuesday, December 17th**. Following that, the counselors from both schools will be registering your student the next day, **Wednesday, December 18th**. Due to the quick turnaround between orientation and registration, we would like to give you and your student ample time to plan their freshman schedule.

The guide gives you information on the various courses your student can take next year. When your student registers for classes, they will be selecting 8 classes: four core classes, two electives and two “alternate” electives.
